Transfers & Cancellation Policies

Once you are registered in a class(es), you will receive an emailed confirmation. The confirmation contains all the class information you need to know about your class(es).

TRANSFERS

CANCELLATIONS

We make every effort to publish accurate course information, but due to unforeseen circumstances some class dates/times may be subject to being rescheduled or cancelled. Any class that does not meet minimum enrollment may be cancelled. If Community Education cancels a class, you will be notified and a full refund will be issued to you.

If you want to cancel a class(es), you need to notify us about the cancellation three (3) or more business days prior to the start of the original class. There is a \$10 cancellation fee for all cancellations. If you notify us after a class has begun, no cancellation can be given.

If you are given a refund, registration fees paid by credit card will be returned to that card within 72 hours or less. Payments made by cash or check will be refunded by check from the District within 2-4 weeks and will be mailed directly to you.
