## SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAM—HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW...



Our summer youth program has three two-week sessions, running Monday through Friday (excluding holidays):

**Session #1: June 22<sup>nd</sup>-July 2<sup>nd</sup>** (no class July 3<sup>rd</sup>)

**Session #2: July 6<sup>th</sup>-July 17<sup>th</sup>**

**Session #3: July 20<sup>th</sup>-July 31<sup>st</sup>**

Classes are offered every two hours (8am, 10am, 1pm, & 3pm).

### ENROLLMENT

- **Students Exposure to College:** These icons below represent the Learning Career Pathways at Cerritos College. Your child will see them throughout the summer on campus as a way to immerse themselves in the Cerritos College Experience.

- On pages 3-4, you will find our **Youth Schedule Planner**; this is our “cheat sheet” to help you easily see the main details about each session (dates, times, class titles).
- Your child is registered in a class upon payment for that class.
- Classes are filled on a first come, first served basis. If a class is full, you can put your child on the waiting list. If a spot opens in that class, you will be contacted to see if you want to register your child at that time.

### TEACHERS & STAFF

- Classes are taught by credentialed teachers, those with college-level experience, or holders of a Bachelor's degree or higher. Enrichment courses are led by subject-experienced instructors.
- Student assistants assist in classes and manage transitions/breaks.
- All teachers, assistants, and staff at Cerritos College are fingerprinted and have clean backgrounds.

### ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

- Please arrive 10-15 minutes before class and drop off your child at the designated area in parking lot 9, where staff and signs will assist you.
- Do not drop off your child prior to 7:45am—there is no supervision before this time. Also please make sure you pick up your child after their class(es) end; there is no supervision 15 minutes after the end of each class.
- A parking pass is required for campus parking. Daily passes are \$3, or you can purchase weekly or monthly passes at [paymycite.com](http://paymycite.com).

### SUPERVISION, BREAKS & LUNCH

- Students are supervised.
- Student assistants help with drop-off/pick-up and ensure children are safely in and out of your car. Please use the designated drop-off/pick-up area.
- Students 12 and under must be accompanied by a staff member or teacher at all times and may not be unsupervised on campus.
- If your child brings a snack, we ask that they eat it during the transition time between classes and not during class.
- Lunch supervision is provided at no additional cost; however, please register your child to assist with planning.
- Lunch break is from 11:45am-12:45pm; your child must bring a sack lunch, there are no campus lunch options available.

### PROGRAM POLICIES

- Only registered students are allowed in classrooms—no parents, adults, or non-registered children.
- Respect for individuals, materials, and equipment is expected. If a student does not adhere to the code of conduct, we will work with them to minimize disruptions.
- Cancellations or transfers require three business days' notice before the start of class. A \$10 fee will be applied to any cancellations or transfers.

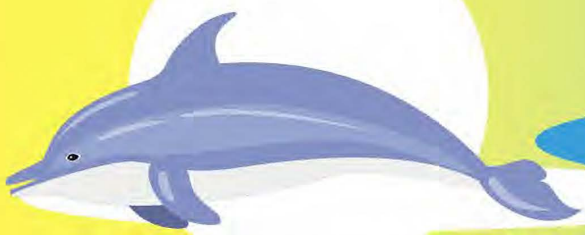

### SWIMMING LEVEL DESCRIPTIONS:

(NOTE: ONLY CHILDREN IN GRADES 1-12 CAN PARTICIPATE IN COLLEGE FOR YOUTH). EACH LEVEL IS OFFERED DURING THE TIMES LISTED BELOW

#### REQUIRED SKILLS PER LEVEL

#### LEVEL 1 (35 MIN. LESSON)

Beginners who are experiencing the water for the first time or are unable to put their face under the water. Students will learn to become comfortable with basic water skills (floating, gliding, kicking, and basic arm movements) and learn good safety habits.

#### LEVEL 2 (35 MIN. LESSON)

Students can perform level 1 skills and are able to relax and hold their breath under water. They will improve in their ability to float, glide and flutter kick and do the basic crawl stroke arm movements on the front and back, unassisted. Students will be introduced to rhythmic breathing.

#### LEVEL 3 (35 MIN. LESSON)

Students can perform level 2 skills, including retrieving objects from shallow water. Students will increase the distance they can swim the front crawl with side breathing and back crawl, learn the elementary backstroke, how to dive into deep water, and how to change directions in the water. They will be introduced to the breaststroke and dolphin kicking.

#### LEVEL 4 (35 MIN. LESSON)

Students can perform level 3 skills. Further refinement of basic strokes-front crawl, back crawl, and elementary backstroke. Introduction to the breaststroke and the butterfly stroke will begin.

### \*FISH OUT OF WATER (FOW) (BEFORE/AFTER SWIM FUN)

The \*\*Fish Out of Water\*\* program provides fun and dynamic out-of-water activities. Children will enjoy a variety of games, learn essential stretching exercises, and practice conditioning techniques that will improve their swimming performance. \*\*Fish Out of Water\*\* provides a great way to get the most out of their aquatic experience!

If your child is in part of College for Youth, you must register your child for both swim lessons and FOW.

\*If your child's swim class is between 10:20am- 11:35am or 1:15pm-2:30pm, our College for Youth staff will take them and pick them up from the pool.

\*If they take a swim class between 9:05am - 10:20am or 11:45pm - 12:20pm, a parent/guardian is responsible for taking them and picking them up from their swim class.

# Transfers & Cancellation Policies

Once you are registered in a class(es), you will receive an emailed confirmation. The confirmation contains all the class information you need to know about your class(es).

## TRANSFERS

To transfer registration to another class, your request must be received three or more business days before the first class meeting. There is a \$10 transfer fee for all transfers completed. We cannot complete any transfer once a class has begun.

## CANCELLATIONS

We make every effort to publish accurate course information, but due to unforeseen circumstances some class dates/times may be subject to being rescheduled or cancelled. Any class that does not meet minimum enrollment may be cancelled. If Community Education cancels a class, you will be notified and a full refund will be issued to you.

If you want to cancel a class(es), you need to notify us about the cancellation three (3) or more business days prior to the start of the original class. There is a \$10 cancellation fee for all cancellations. If you notify us after a class has begun, no cancellation can be given.

If you are given a refund, registration fees paid by credit card will be returned to that card within 72 hours or less. Payments made by cash or check will be refunded by check from the District within 2-4 weeks and will be mailed directly to you.
